

7th Grade Supplies List 2019-2020 School Year

“Tool Kit” Items - The following items are general supplies, which will be needed in all classes:

- Something new this year!! Accordion folder to help organize homework
- Pencil bag
- Set of colored pencils
- Ruler
- Bottle of rubber cement or glue
- Pair of scissors
- Several packages of #2 lead pencils
- Highlighter
- Box of Kleenex to homeroom
- Several ballpoint pens (black, blue or red)
- Scientific calculator is RECOMMENDED, but not required, as calculators are available for use in ALL math classrooms

Items for Core Classes

English

- One black & white composition book
- 1 pocket folder
- Loose leaf paper (100 sheets)
- Blue/black ink & red ink pens
- Pencils
- Post It Notes
- Highlighters
- Post It Flags
- 3 ring binder
- 3 dividers for binder

Math

- 3-ring binder
- Two dividers
- Loose-leaf paper (no spiral paper!)
- 4 AAA batteries

Science

- 3-ring binder
- Loose leaf paper

Social Studies

- 3-ring binder
- Three dividers
- Loose leaf paper
- 1 folder with pockets

Items for Elective Classes

Art - Art kit containing:

- **Required:** Black Sharpies (fine tip and ultra fine tip) pink eraser, pencils, Spiral 9 x 12 sketchbook, rubber cement, 1 bottle of Elmer's Glue (4 oz) , masking tape, colored pencils, ruler, scissors, 1 box of watercolors

Band

- Band instrument and maintenance supplies (reeds, oil, cleaning swab)
- Pencil to leave in music folder
- Khaki dress pants for performances
- Tennis shoes for marching band rehearsals
- Luggage tag with first and last name to attach to instrument case

Choir

- Pencil to leave in music folder
- Khaki dress pants for concerts

Family and Consumer Sciences (FaCS)

- Two-pocket folder with 3-prong fasteners

Physical Education and Health Enhancement

- Gym shoes
- Socks
- T-shirt
- Shorts or sweats
- Lock for gym locker (optional but highly recommended)

General information when buying materials

1. Each three ring binder should be labeled for the specific class in which it will be used.
2. Loose leaf paper should be college ruled.
3. A lock for locker is recommended but not mandatory. The combination will be given to the homeroom teacher and an extra key for keyed locks will be given to the office.
4. Backpacks can be used to take books to and from school but are not allowed in class.
5. Materials needed for classes not listed will be specified during the first week of class.
